## MAKING A DIFFERENCE DURING COVID-19

Bombardier has supplied 40,000 face shields for the province of Quebec during the month of April. Production took place at Bombardier Transportation Prototype Center in Montreal, with key assistance from Bombardier Aviation in sourcing and obtaining raw materials.

Bombardier has donated protective equipment such as N-95 masks, gloves and Tyvek suits from its various sites to medical communities in Ontario & Quebec.

Bombardier Transportation facility in Thunder Bay is helping in production of portable e700 ventilators for Ontario, in conjunction with a Canadian medical tech. company.

The Joseph-Armand Bombardier Foundation, Bombardier's philanthropic arm, recently donated \$250,000 to non-profit organizations in need of emergency funds as they work with vulnerable people in Quebec and Ontario. The Foundation also donated \$100,000 to the Montreal Heart Institute, to support a clinical study on the use of colchicine in conjunction with COVID-19.

Where possible, Bombardier is using its demo aircraft to help ferry personal protective equipment where needed as well as transport people requiring assistance to access medical care.
