Application Requirements

1. Applicant must be a Canadian citizen or permanent resident. Proof of citizenship or residency will be requested.
2. Applicants must be applying the bursary toward training in flight support (schedulers, dispatchers, flight coordinators, admin support etc.).
3. This form must be completed in its entirety and signed. Applications that have not been properly completed will be disqualified.
4. Submit a typed essay of 500 words or less with the application form. Essay requirements are described on page 2.
5. Provide two work-related letters of recommendation and submit them with the application form.
6. Submit a current resume with the application form.
7. Applications must be received by CBAACAA **May 1st, 2019.**

If you are awarded the scholarship, please note that the following conditions will apply:

1. The scholarship will be paid directly to educational institute or training provider and for direct expenses related to costs associated with your education or training.
2. You will be asked to submit a typed essay of 250 words or less outlining how you used the scholarship and how it affected your education.

State the amount of funds required for such programs, up to \$10,000. Specify dates, locations and all estimated costs, including any associated travel, lodging and meal expenses.
3. Discuss your professional goals and how the scholarship will help you reach them.
